## **General Elementary Everglades Experience Itinerary**

8:00-8:15	Students picked up from school and loaded onto bus.
8:15-9:00	On bus, students receive a safety briefing, background on the Everglades and are divided into 2 wildlife biology teams and further divided into 4 sub teams.
9:00-9:20	Students unload from bus, they are escorted to outdoor lab and continue with Everglades introduction.
9:20-11:10	Groups A & B are split to do their morning activities:  *Group A goes on the airboat: bird ID, water quality testing, understands wate management in South Florida, human impact  *Group B goes slogging (walking through the Everglades): geology of Florida, ethnobotany, significance of the aquifer, human impact, critter lab analysis, lunch

11:10-1:00 Groups A & B are split to do their afternoon activities:

\*Group B goes on the airboat: bird ID, water quality testing, understands water management in South Florida, human impact

\*Group A goes slogging (walking through the Everglades): lunch, critter lab analysis, geology of Florida, ethnobotany, significance of the aquifer, human impact

1:00-1:45 All students return to the outdoor lab and load onto the bus. During the bus ride home, the day is wrapped-up.
